





# The Landscapes Review proposes (Proposal 26) reformed governance to inspire and secure ambition in our national landscapes and better reflect society.

New guidance will set out clear governance principles, processes, and structures that local authorities would be expected to follow.

This guidance will be flexible enough to be adapted to local circumstances but would aim to improve consistency, performance, and transparency.

The Government response to the Landscapes review highlights important principles including:

- diversity of experience,
- collaboration towards strategic priorities
- governance having the essential skills
- democratic accountability
